State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program

United States Department of Homeland Security

The Department of Homeland Security will award \$1 billion over four years to states and tribal governments to address cybersecurity risks to information systems owned or operated by, or on behalf of, state, local, or tribal governments. The application period for states and tribes is expected to open in Summer 2022.

- States and tribes must create
 Cybersecurity Plans to address
 cybersecurity threats to IT systems in
 their jurisdictions.
- A local government that receives a subgrant must follow its state's Cybersecurity Plan.
- Institutions of public education and public health will send representatives to states' Cybersecurity Planning Committees to decide how funds will be distributed.
